Visitor Rules

Welcome

Visitors are invited to explore designated areas of the 15 acres of The Turtle River Falls and Gardens, and are requested to comply with the following rules which are for your own safety and comfort. We thank you for your cooperation.

Visitor Rules

- Currently The Restaurant and Grill are not open: in the meantime visitors are allowed to carry their own food on property.
- On booking, a Designated-Person-in-Charge of the Group must be named.
- Visitors are responsible for damages to the property caused by them.
- Do not pick the flowers, or take plant cuttings.
- Do not litter.
- Visitors climb the Falls at their own risk
- No climbing on trees, rocks or other structures.
- Keep out of the ponds.
- No pets are allowed on the property.
- Do not feed the fish.
- Do not throw garbage (plates, cups, bottles, etc) in the river
- No boom boxes or loud music allowed.
- No butterfly net or fish net is allowed
- No smoking allowed on property
- No illegal drugs allowed on property
- Visitors who are uncertain of their ability to swim should wear a life vest before entering pools.
- Parents/Guardians are required to monitor and supervise their children at all times
- No glass containers allowed on the waterfalls
- Please observe the hours of operation. We close promptly at the posted closing hours.
- No diving allowed
- No running on Pool Deck
- No swinging on vines or other hanging material

Photographer Guidelines & Required Registration

There is a photographic session fee of US\$250 per session for a group of ten or less visitors.

Additional visitors are required to pay the regular admission fee of:

- Non-resident Adult – US\$20
- Non-resident Child – US\$10,
- Resident Adult – J\$1,000
- Resident Child – J\$500

Each session is two hours. Each additional hour after the first two hours attracts a fee of US\$150.

These arrangements would include such occasions as weddings, engagements, posed, formal, and family or group photographs.

Photographic sessions should be arranged in advance.

Registration and payment of the fee must be done between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. in the Main Office of the Turtle River Falls and Gardens.

In general snapshots are not included in the foregoing; please contact the Main Office if you have questions.

Additional Photographer Guidelines

- Please stay out of the flowerbeds and do not disturb any plant identification signs or other signs. Photographs may be taken on paved, gravel or grass covered areas;
 - Even though flowerbeds may appear empty, nevertheless, perennial plant shoots may be growing just below the surface of the soil. Stepping on such shoots may destroy the plants.
 - Stepping between plants compacts the soil producing a hard surface that prevents the absorption of water and impedes the development of roots, thereby creating bald spots during the growing season.
- Do not block garden walkways: allow enough room for visitors to walk freely.
- Do not pose your subjects in trees, on rocks, fences or other such structures.
- Ladies should wear walking shoes between shots to prevent tripping or ruining good shoes.
- Please observe the hours of operation and allow enough time for your photo sessions. The property closes promptly at the posted closing hours.
